THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH

This month, Alison presents 'Thoughts from Pentecost'



I have said these things to you while I am with you. But the Advocate (Helper), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

John 14: 25-27

We have just celebrated 'Pentecost', complete with flames, made by Kay, Karen and myself some years ago and wind, made in the service by some very competent Beavers.

It occurred to me that the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, is not much mentioned in our tradition. I wondered if it was that the other two persons of the Trinity, The Father creator and The Son, Jesus Christ our saviour, are rather more understandable persons. We can relate to these more easily because they are human relationships and their roles are recognisable. The Spirit seems 'other worldly' and we are down to earth people? However if we look at the Bible we can read that all three were present at creation and Jesus, humanly speaking, was continually in touch with The Spirit and The Father.

Before Jesus was crucified we read in John's Gospel, that he told his followers that The Spirit would be sent to them with the job of encouragement, bringing truth, and 'reminding the followers of all that Jesus had said and done. Giving the followers the power to tell and demonstrate to the world the Good News of Jesus Christ. In so doing, he does not draw attention to himself. *John V Taylor calls him the 'Gobetween-God' because he now acts as the link between the individual members of the worldwide church and the Father and the Son.

Looking back over my journey of faith, I can see points at which I have 'seen the light' of the Good News and been surprised by thoughts that have sprung to mind of revelation, and maybe directions that would not go away. I suspect that these were the work of the Holy Spirit, enlightening my understanding and helping me to come to faith and to make a commitment to follow Jesus. That still small voice of the Spirit? I imagine you have had these moments too? There is much to be

thankful for.

God's Gift -- Our World

Many people think it best to charge their phone/laptop all the way up and then use it until it's nearly dead. This is wrong - it's better to charge lithium-ion batteries up to about 80%, then plug it in again if it gets below 50% - don't let it drop to zero and only charge it to 100% once a month or two. Leaving it to charge overnight is bad as keeps it in high-tension state, wearing down the chemistry within.

Don't forget, you can recycle the following items at London Street:

Empty Printer Cartridges, Aluminium Containers and Foil, Batteries, and Plastic Milk Bottle Tops.

Can you help to make sure that no one in our local community goes hungry?



Items **urgently** needed: UHT Fruit Juice, Savoury Spreads (e.g. Peanut Butter, Marmite), Hot/Cold Desserts (e.g. Jelly, Sponge Pudding, Angel Delight), Tinned Meat (e.g. Chilli, Stewing Steak, Ham), Deodorant, Shopping Bags.

Items needed: UHT Milk, Savoury Snacks, Shower Gel, Toothpaste, Loo Roll, Cup-a-Soup, Crackers, Coffee, Tampons, Hair Conditioner, Household Cleaning Products and Washing Up Liquid, Powdered Milk, Squash, Sweet Spreads (Jam, Marmalade etc.), Pet Food.

Please **do not** give Baby Food, Hot/Cold Cereal, Nappies, Non-Dairy Milk, Pasta, Pulses, Rice, Sanitary Pads, or Tinned Beans, as these are already in surplus.


